

Ancient Greek (or Persian) Poster Assignment

Your task is to create a one-page poster about an Ancient Greek or Persian figure you find compelling. The goal is not just to report facts, but to explain why this person matters and why they are worth remembering.

Poster Requirements

- Name and Dates: Include the person's name and approximate dates or century.
- Place: Where they lived and worked. A small map is encouraged.
- Why They Matter: Clearly state the main idea, achievement, or reason this figure is significant.
- Quotation: Include one short quotation attributed to them. Briefly explain what it means.
- Historical Context: Describe the political, cultural, or historical situation that shaped them.
- Visuals: Use relevant images (statues, vase paintings, coins, scenes, diagrams). Images should support understanding, not just decoration.
- Human Detail: Include at least one personal or biographical detail that makes them human (death, exile, reputation, controversies, etc.).
- Defense Sentence: End with one sentence explaining why this person deserves attention over others.

Format Guidelines

- Poster must be clear, readable, and visually organized.
- Use your own words. Do not copy directly from sources.
- Cite sources briefly at the bottom of the poster.

Evaluation Criteria

Posters will be evaluated on clarity, accuracy, depth of understanding, effective use of visuals, and the quality of explanation and argument.
