

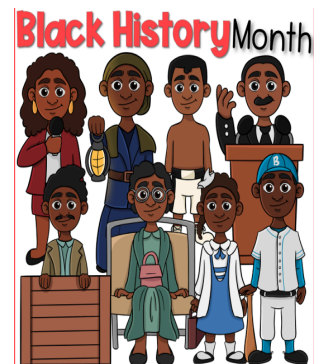
Black History Project
