Each student will choose an important person in Black history and create a banner using construction paper. The entire project must be handwritten by the student.

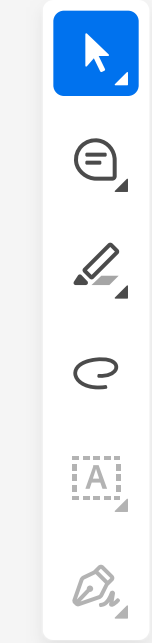
The banner must include:
