

# Biome Travel Itinerary

## Requirements:

1. Study each biome we covered
2. Chose three biomes, one in each zone (there are three zones, the biomes can be in different hemispheres)
3. Create a travel itinerary explaining and describing a following:
  - a. Geographical location of your biome – give physical location, ex. Gobi Desert
  - b. Temperature/climate
  - c. Rainfall/seasons
  - d. Abiotic factors
  - e. Biotic factors: (biodiversity)
    - i. Types of organisms found there (examples of plants, animals, fungi, etc.)
  - f. Describe WHY it is important to PROTECT the biome you are traveling to.
4. Include photographs of the biome, enhanced by graphs, charts, and/or diagrams (requirement: 3 photographs, 3 graph, chart, and/or diagram for EACH biome)
5. Work in groups of 3, print is **NOT a requirement.**
- 6. The format is a tree-fold pamphlet – research what that is (6 pages to cover)**
